Low Budget Performance Series is a collection of low cost but high value performances by the Swiss artist MARTIN SCHICK and his collabpromoted orators, performatively throughout this prospectus designed by Mirko Winkel. By borrowing and exposing elements from the tacky shopping universe, an intersection of art & commerce is created, layering irony onto the controversial act of selling art, resp. the commodification of performances, and the performativity of commerce.


This **thematic compilation** consists of works which developed in various production contexts over years of continuous practice. Most of them manifested as side-effects. They are produced (some intentionally, some accidently) without an externally sourced production budget and/or **combine the process of production and creation**.

Behind that **experimental way** of dealing with distribution lies the artist's wish to look at his own condition and the power relations that define current and future interdependencies. The conscious limitation the **lowest possible expense** n

provokes reflections on the circumstances of contemporary performance art production (culture budget cuts, competitive festivals, international touring demands) but also call established values and aesthetics into question, claiming a certain aesthetic and value system of its own. The simplicity allows for a focus on content. The idea of something sunfinished and lacking in monetary means forces the audience, the organizer, and the artist himself, to actively experience these mostly socio-economic topics rather than consuming them as commodified art products. effect is a beautifully staged fragilithin an unspectacular setup.

- 1. All prices are in Euro!
- 2. Prices exclude 2nd class travel costs & accommodation!
